So I, Abram, departed as the Lord had said unto me, & Lot with me, *(&) I Abram was 6 *(&) 2 years old when I departed out of Haran. And I took Sarai, whom I took to wife when I was in Ur, in Chaldea, & Lot my brothers Son, & all our substance that we had gathered, & the souls that we had won in Haran, & came forth in the way to the land of canaan, & dwelt in tents
